Privacy

FormFox is committed to safeguarding the information you entrust to FormFox and believes you should know how FormFox utilizes the information collected.

The Information We Collect

FormFox may collect personally identifiable information from you in a variety of ways. Personally identifiable information may include (i) contact data (such as your name, mailing and e-mail addresses); (ii) financial data (such as your account or credit card number); and (iii) demographic data (such as your zip code, age and income). If you communicate with FormFox by e-mail, post messages to any forums, or otherwise complete online forms, surveys or contest entries, any information provided in such communication may be collected by FormFox. FormFox may also collect information about how you use our Website, for example, by tracking the number of unique views received by the pages of the Website, or the domains from which you originate. We may use “cookies” to track how you use our Website. A cookie is a piece of software that a Web server can store on your PC and use to identify you should you visit the Website again. We may use third party ad networks to serve ads on the Website. The cookies received with banner ads served by these networks are used to collect and build anonymous behavioral profiles by these companies to deliver targeted ads and tracking referrals, and FormFox generally does not have access to this information.
